- Criteria include:
- Selectivity Rate
 - Graduation Rate
 - Retention Rate (Freshman to Sophomore)
 - Faculty to Student Ratio
 - Percentage of Classes under 20 Students
 - Percentage of Residential Students on Campus
 - Undergraduate Student Body Size
 - Percentage of Undergraduate Degrees Coferred
 - Experiential Learning Opportunities
 - Alumni Giving Rate
 - Student Involvement in Campus Activities
 - Percentage of Full-Time Faculty
 - Percentage of Faculty on Tenure Tracks
 - Rate of Employment after Graduation
 - Rate of Graduate School Acceptance for Alumni
